

CAPRI (Claysville Area Preservation and Revitalization Initiative) received a grant to help deploy High Speed Internet into the McGuffey area.

For DSL deployment a form called the BFRR or Bona Fide Retail Request form must be completed.

The BFRR program is quite simple. In areas where no DSL service is available, residents can submit a form that requests it. Once either 50 local phone company customers or 25 percent of customers in a given area submit the form (whichever is less), high speed Internet (DSL) will be provided within a year.

Residents may complete the BFRR form online, complete the attached form or contact Lynn Dutton.

To complete the form, you will need your account number, which can be located on the first page of your bill. It is a thirteen-digit number consisting of your billing telephone number plus a three-digit code.
